About The Founders

Co-Founder Daquan Thompson has been trained in ballet, jazz, modern, and hip hop techniques from the age of 6. He began gymnastics training at the age of 9. He was introduced to cheer when attending high school at the Girard Academic Music Program (G.A.M.P.) where he studied Musical Theatre. While attending the University of the Arts as a Dance major Daquan was also the assistant coach and choreographer of G.A.M.P.'s cheer squad earning them three Philadelphia Public League Championships. Since 2004, they have not placed lower then 2nd place under his leadership. Daquan has worked and trained with several dance companies such as Koresh Dance Company, Philadanco, Eleone Dance Theatre, Dance Theater X, and Elisa Monte Dance Company. He has also had extensive training at The Alvin Ailey School in New York City. Daquan has worked as a freelance dancer and choreographer outside his concert dance career. Dynasty Spirit Elite is a brand new all star program in Philadelphia opening its doors to all youth age 18 and under. We will be starting the 2010 season May 3rd, 2010. We encourage our athletes to be strong supporters of each other as one Royal Family.

Process

The beginning of the season will consist of molding and training our athletes as one unit. After the initial team placement and a few months of training, we will reevaluate to place each athlete in the proper training group. These groups will be determined by age, skill level, and progression. Our coaching staff will also evaluate consistency, positive attitude, work ethic, and attendance from the previous month when making the decision on team placement.

Financial Policies

Monthly Dues & Late Fee

Monthly Dues are to be paid by the 4th Friday of each month for Summer/Fall Session and 3rd Friday for Winter/Spring Session and will be considered late after the 1st of the following month, i.e. Due Date is June 26, payments made after July 1 are considered late. There will be a \$25 late fee assessed.

Payment Due to Missed or Added Practice

There will be no pro-ration for missed or cancelled practices. There may be practices rescheduled due to cancellations. You can expect a small number of practices to be cancelled due to holidays, competitions, rest days following competitions, inclement weather, and practice facility closing periods.

Outstanding Balances

Athletes will **NOT** be allowed to participate in practice or competition until balance is paid in full. All missed practices count as absences regardless of financial status.

Methods of Payment

Payments may be made in the form of check, money order, or credit card through Paypal via the website (Paypal fee is assessed for credit card users). They may be turned in any practice or dropped off at our business address.

Checks and Money Orders

All payments should be made out to Dynasty Spirit Elite All Stars, Inc. Please do not mail payments to our practice facility or business address. All payments made via check or money order need to be turned in at practice or at our business address. Dynasty Spirit Elite will charge a \$35 fee for any check that is returned due to insufficient funds and you will not be able to pay via checks going forward.

Sibling Discounts

A \$25 discount will be applied to the monthly tuition for the 2nd and 3rd sibling. Ex: 1st Child pays \$75, 2nd Child pays \$50, 3rd Child pays \$50, 4th Child pays \$50 etc.

USASF Level Status

USASF

The United States All-Star Federation (USASF) was created to help standardize the industry. The USASF took input from industry leaders to come up with a logical system of determining the various divisions, levels, and rules. In order to be an All-Star and compete at a USASF sanctioned event, every all-star must be credentialed through the USASF. A \$25 fee is required, and coaches will fill out the necessary paperwork needed. Your age as of August 31st, 2009 will determine your "competition age" for that entire season. In other words, if you are 14 on August 31st, you compete as a "14 year old" for that entire season, even if you turn 15 on September 1st. There is no minimum age requirement for any of the regular divisions, except for the potential of a 12 year minimum age for select senior divisions. USASF LEVEL STATUS

The above chart was created as a quick reference for our competitive All-Stars and parents to understand how Dynasty Spirit Elite will select their teams according to the USASF. The chart is based off of standing tumbling, running tumbling and stunting ability.



Rules & Regulations

I hereby understand that each time "Dynasty Spirit Elite" is mentioned throughout this contract it is meant to be all inclusive of Dynasty Spirit Elite All Stars, Inc., its officers, board members, agents, and employees.

GENERAL

- 1. All Practices are **<u>CLOSED</u>**. Only registered athletes are allowed in the practice area.
- 2. Siblings, family members, friends, etc. are not allowed in the practice area.
- 3. All spectators must remain in the designated area and keep the noise level down at all times. Any person that disrupts a practice will be asked to leave the gym immediately.
- 4. No food, gum, or drinks other than water are permitted in the practice area.
- 5. All trash must be disposed in the appropriate trash receptacles.
- 6. Cell phones and pagers must be put on silent mode or left outside of the practice area. This includes parents and Coaches cell phones.
- 7. Dynasty Spirit Elite is not responsible for any personal items lost, misplaced, or stolen.
- 8. The Dynasty Spirit Elite website and E-mails must be checked daily for any and all updates. There is no excuse for being uninformed or irresponsible when the information has been provided.
- 9. All completed forms and documents must be released to Dynasty Spirit Elite staff before participation of any kind is allowed. This includes registration forms, waiver and release forms, copy of birth certificate, and proof of insurance.
- 10. Dynasty Spirit Elite must approve any privately monogrammed clothing bearing the Dynasty Spirit Elite name. Anything created without approval will not be acceptable and cannot be worn or sold separately.
- 11. All choreography including cheers, dances, stunts, transitions, tumbling, music selections, editing, etc. should be highly protected and shall not be shown or discussed with others. NO VIDEOS of routines/choreography should be uploaded to any online site such as YOUTUBE!

TEAMS

- > Dynasty Spirit Elite retains the right to:
 - 1. Place its athletes on the team(s) it feels will best suit them and the program. .
 - 2. Move, replace, add, suspend, or even dismiss an athlete for a period of time or indefinitely from a team or the entire program based on criteria including but not limited to:
 - A. Attendance
 - B. Conduct
 - C. Skills
 - D. Finances
 - E. Parent conflicts
 - 3. Decide if an athlete may participate on more than one team.
 - 4. Decide the roles and/or positions an athlete will have/play on their team(s). (E.g. base, flyer, back spot, tumbler, dancer, alternate, etc.).
 - 5. Request that an athlete or team take additional classes, privates or camps to improve their skills.

6. Request that an athlete or team practice longer than their regularly scheduled time or add additional practices, camps, or competitions if deemed necessary.

Athletes that elect to participate on more than one Dynasty Spirit Elite team must:

- 1. Be in good financial standing.
- 2. Be willing and able to fulfill all responsibilities required by each team.
- 3. Be responsible for any additional entry fees they incur beyond their first team.

ATTENDANCE/INJURIES

Lateness and absences will not be tolerated. Sicknesses should be reported at least 2 hours prior to the start of practice BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. In the event of extreme weather or a road generally backed up when you're traveling to practice- prepare your self to leave early. Five absences will result in dismissal from the program.

All athletes must:

- 1. Make Dynasty Spirit Elite priority over any other extracurricular activities.
- 2. Attend and be prepared to participate in all Dynasty Spirit Elite activities including those unexpectedly added throughout the season regardless of illness or injury unless otherwise recommended by a doctor through valid written documentation.
- 3. Notify Dynasty Spirit Elite immediately when an injury occurs so changes to routine choreography can be made prior to practice.
- 4. Arrive at least <u>15 minutes</u> early to all Dynasty Spirit Elite activities. Practices will start on time with or without an athlete present. Any participant over 15 min. late without notifying Dynasty Spirit Elite prior will not be allowed to practice.
- 5. Schedule all vacations so as not to interfere with any Dynasty Spirit Elite activities.
- 6. Notify Dynasty Spirit Elite in writing immediately of all expected tardiness or absences.
- 7. Notify Dynasty Spirit Elite by phone immediately of any unexpected tardiness or absences.

DRESS CODE

All athletes must adhere to dress code below:

- 1. Maintain a well-groomed appearance and good personal hygiene at all times.
- 2. Have all hair pulled up out of the athlete's face with practice bow. Long individual braids or hair extensions that reach down the spine of the athlete even after hair is pulled up is a safety hazard and is not permitted.
- 3. Keep nails shorter than fingertips when participating in any physical Dynasty Spirit Elite activity. Excessively long fingernails are not permitted.
- 4. No jewelry (other than approved medical ID tags) is allowed when wearing any Dynasty Spirit Elite, practice, warm up, camp, or competition uniform.
- 5. No tattoos or inappropriately dyed or cut hairstyles should be visible when wearing any Dynasty Spirit Elite apparel at events.
- 6. Sandals, flip flops, or open-toed shoes are not allowed when wearing any Dynasty Spirit Elite practice, warm up, camp, or competition uniform.
- 7. All lost or noticeably damaged uniform items must be repurchased immediately and a matching substitute worn until the item is replaced.

Competition Rules/Dress Code

All athletes are to:

- 1. Schedule all family vacations around competition dates.
- 2. Arrive at competition or designated meeting area at the designated time as instructed and posted on website prior to each competition.
- 3. Wear the appropriate make up as described by coaching staff.
- 4. Remain at the competition from beginning to awards, unless otherwise instructed.
- 5. Not to wear jewelry or nail polish to competitions.
- 6. Be ready to go to warm-ups 20 minutes prior to warm up start time.
- 7. Transportation will not be provided by Dynasty Spirit Elite. Direction will be provided on the website prior to each event.
- 8. All competition dates, venues, and itineraries will be released to parents as soon as the information is available. Please check the website regularly for updates and postings.

By each team's scheduled meeting time:

1. Athletes must be dressed as specified below unless instructed otherwise by their coach.

- 2. All rollers must be taken out and hair and make-up must be complete as per coach's request.
- 3. Girls are NOT allowed to walk around in sports bras.
- 4. Skirts must be buttoned at all times during competitions and events.
- 5. All jewelry (except approved medical ID tags) and colored nail polish must be removed.
- 6. All non-uniform items such as sunglasses, cell phones, CD players, and iPods must be put away.
- 7. Any braces or tape needed to perform must be supplied by the athlete and put on before going to warm up mat.

After competing:

- 1. Athletes may only change into their official Dynasty Spirit Elite competition t-shirt and warm ups.
- 2. No skirts may be worn over warm up pants.
- 3. Socks and sneakers must be worn at all times.

During awards ceremonies, athletes must be in full competition uniform and may not wear backpacks, warm ups or any other items.

SPORTSMANSHIP/CONDUCT

All athletes **AND** parents must always:

- 1. Set a positive example for others to follow.
- 2. Be respectful and courteous to everyone.
- 3. Schedule an appointment to speak with a coach or other staff member to discuss any issues that may arise.
- 4. Refrain from gossiping or any form of verbal or physical confrontation.
- 5. Refrain from celebrating the misfortune or defeat of another person, team, or program.
- 6. Accept team placements and awards with dignity and class.

<u>HEALTH</u>

All athletes must:

- 1. Provide Dynasty Spirit Elite with current health insurance and emergency contact information.
- 2. Inform Dynasty Spirit Elite of all medical conditions that may limit or prevent their ability to participate in any Dynasty Spirit Elite activities.
- 3. Notify Dynasty Spirit Elite of any injuries sustained as a result of their participation in any sanctioned Dynasty Spirit Elite activities.
- 4. Provide valid written documentation from a doctor explaining the reason(s) and the duration for which they may be limited or unable to participate in any Dynasty Spirit Elite activities.
- 5. Provide Dynasty Spirit Elite with a list of any medications that they are currently taking.
- 6. Refrain from the illegal use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco or any other substances.
- 7. Participate in any drug or health related testing, counseling, or rehabilitation if asked to do so.

TRAVEL / COMPETITIONS

All athletes and their families must:

- 1. Have all travel arrangements booked by the travel block black out dates.
- 2. Arrive to competition by the designated check-in time and will check- in with the coaches/staff/gym owners accordingly.
- 3. Not use the competitions as family vacations and will therefore follow the designated schedules and abide by all rules set forth by Dynasty Spirit Elite.
- 4. Find competition dates, venues and itineraries on the Dynasty Spirit Elite website.

FINES

There will be a \$5 fine assessed when an athlete is not ready for practice, competition, or an event. For example, if an athlete is missing/wearing incorrect bows, tops, bottoms, socks, sneakers, ankle weights, wearing jewelry, or chewing gum, the athlete is not ready for practice and will be assessed a fine.

There will be a \$1/minute late fee assessed when an athlete is not picked up from practice, competition, or an event on time.

All fines are due at the next practice.
